Blandwood is one of the America's great historic homes, representing the ideals of progressive North Carolina Governor John Motley Morehead as illustrated through a prototype for one of America's most popular architectural styles in the nineteenth century. The earliest portions of were completed in 1795 with completion in 1846. Blandwood operates as a museum, and provides visitors with a remarkably complete ensemble of 19th century art, architecture, furnishings, and landscape. The house was nominated to the National Register of Historic Places in 1970. It is the only building in Guilford County recognized by the United States Secretary of the Interior as a National Historic Landmark.

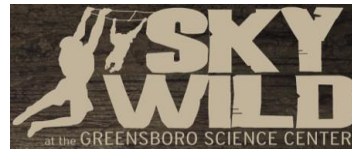
