Return the Favor – New concept for 2019-20

We are all familiar with the prior Return the Favor (RTF) program where we submitted hours based on our support of Jaycee activities with manpower, training, mentoring, etc. While we all enjoyed the ability to submit the RTP forms, the hours didn't always represent the true hope of helping the Jaycees grow and meet their leadership development goals.

So for 2019-2020, there is a new (some may say renewed) emphasis on mentoring, training and helping the Jaycee organization grow. As such, manpower hours will no longer be part of the process; rather, your assistance to recruit or reactivate members will be emphasized, along with providing training/mentoring. Letters of Recommendation must be submitted by your Jaycee organization leaders that details when and what type of support you provided to the Jaycee chapter(s). At least one letter of recommendation is needed, and of course more letters may be provided.

From all the submissions to US JC Senate, three (3) Senators will be awarded recognition each trimester, along with three (3) Senators being recognized for Year End. You can submit your RTF documentation every trimester if you wish.

The new RTF form is available on the US JCI Senate website, and will also be available on our NC JCI Senate website as well. As you will need the letter of recommendation to go with this RTF form, I highly encourage you to speak the Jaycee officers you are assisting and request the completion of the recommendation as soon as you can (you don't have to wait until just before the deadline!). Scan in the letter and RTF form and submit it to me, Elizabeth Pfrogner, at eapfrogner@aol.com on or before the following deadlines:

August 30, 2019

November 29, 2019

May 29, 2019

You can also have the Jaycee officer send the letter of recommendation directly to me if you wish.
